Individual registrants will be placed on a team in the Women's Thursday League starting September 17th and ending October 29th at Laroche Park.

Player Fees

Individual player fees for 2009 include GST and are \$45 per individual player. Fees are payable upon registration and cheques will not be cashed until your spot in the league is confirmed. Cheques should be made payable to OCUA or Ottawa-Carleton Ultimate Association. OCUA has a pay before you play policy. Fees must be paid in full before play as an individual can commence.

Refund Policy

A \$15 administration fee will be charged to all withdrawals up to 2 weeks before the league begins. After this point in time, fees are non-refundable.

Member's Acceptance of Risk of Injury

While the sport of Ultimate is a non-contact sport, this does not mean that contact will never occur. Ultimate is a fastpaced, athletic sport and as such has all the attendant risks that are commonly associated with such an activity. While all players are expected to adhere to the spirit of sportsmanship as outlined in the rules of the sport, it is not possible to absolutely ensure that contact between players will not occur, and that injuries will not be sustained. Members are reminded that they engage in the sport entirely at their own risk.

Captain's and Assistant Captain's Responsibility for Safe Playing Conditions

Given that OCUA offers the sport of Ultimate at varied and dispersed locations, and does not have officials such as referees at the games, it falls to the team captains and assistant captains to be responsible for the safety of the site at which they are playing and for the well-being of their players. Captains are responsible to examine the field of play before their game begins to determine if it is safe. They are responsible for the actions of their players and must be prepared to take appropriate action if they feel that the safety of any player on the field is being compromised. This includes refusal to play on a site they deem to be potentially hazardous, or against an opponent they feel is playing in an unsafe fashion. OCUA never forces its members to play in unsafe circumstances; games can be rescheduled.
