The How's and Why's of OCUA's 2003 Registration Form

1) Captain's & 2nd Contact Information

You will note that most of this information is mandatory. Notification (offers of league vacancies, problems, etc.) will be made using this information, primarily through email as well as Ultimate Happenings and the OCUA web site.

Please keep OCUA informed of any changes to this information!

2) 2003 Choices

You will have the chance to make three selections for possible nights of play. Your first choice will be given the greatest weight. You will be contacted before the Captains Meeting and told if you have gotten a spot. If you have then you must attend the Captains meeting at Hall A of the Nepean Sportsplex at 6:30pm, where the remainder of your team fees will be collected, and you will have an opportunity for questions and answers with your coordinator. **NOTE:** If you are given your first choice and do not take it your deposit is forfeit. If you are given your second choice and do not take it then 50% of your deposit is forfeit, if you are offered your third choice and decline it then you will be subject to a \$25 processing fee only.

3) Placement advice

Please note that due in part to an agreement the Association currently has with the City to limit our growth on traditionally heavy use days, the only night that there are openings on is Friday. As a consequence of this, Friday teams are now granted priority when a spot opens up on another night.

EACH NIGHT OF PLAY REQUIRES A SEPARATE FORM AND DEPOSIT.

If your team plays on both Mondays and Wednesdays (for example) then you must fill in two separate forms and two separate deposit cheques (albeit with a lot of the same information.) The balance of your team fees are due on the 24th of April at the combined Captains Meeting and Registration, which will be held in Hall A at the Nepean Sportsplex at 6:30pm.
