## Summer 2006 Registration Form for Returning Teams Due March 20, 2006

### Before You Register....

Please read the following information before completing the registration form of Page 2.

**Team Fees** Per-team fees for 2006 are \$950+GST (\$1016.50) for Monday to Thursday and \$750+GST (\$802.50) for Fridays. A non-refundable deposit of \$250 must accompany the registration form, the balance to be paid at or before the captains' meeting. Cheques should be made payable to "OCUA" or "Ottawa-Carlton Ultimate Association".

**Annual General Meeting and Captains Meeting** Captains are required to be familiar with the Member Motions and Proxy Process for the Annual General Meeting to be held on April 19th, 2006 at the Nepean Sportsplex. Documents are available at [www.ocua.ca](http://www.ocua.ca)

**Captain's and Assistant Captain's Responsibility for safe playing conditions.** Given that OCUA offers the sport of ultimate at varied and dispersed locations, and does not have officials such as referees at the games, it falls to the team captains and assistant captains to be responsible for the safety of the site at which they are playing and for the well being of their players. Captains are responsible to examine the field of play before their game begins, to determine if it is safe. They are ultimately responsible for the actions of their players and must be prepared to take appropriate action if they feel that safety is being compromised. This includes refusing to play on a site they deem to be potentially hazardous, or against an opponent they feel is playing in an unsafe fashion. OCUA never forces its members to play when they are not comfortable doing so; games can easily be rescheduled.

**2006 Team Name/Old Team Name** Fill in the name of your team for the 2006 summer season. If you are a returning team from the 2005 summer season, please fill in your team name from that year under "**Old Team Name**". Please note that any question over the status of a team (new versus returning) will be determined by consulting the 2005 records for the team name and captain's name. If we cannot find the team name listed in the records, then this team will be considered a new team and placed on the waiting list. Under current OCUA policy, all team spots are the property of the Captains. To transfer this right the former Captain must make OCUA aware of the change.

**Captain's & 2nd Contact Information** You will note that most of this information is mandatory. Notification (offers of league vacancies, problems, etc.) will be made using this information, primarily through e-mail as well as Ultimate Happenings and the OCUA web site. Please keep OCUA informed of any changes to this information! Wherever possible, try to get last year's captain to fill out the form. It will help avoid any confusion on OCUA's part. If this is not possible, please keep the information as close as possible to last year. Contact information/Team Names can always be changed at a later date. As returning teams have different privileges than new teams, please ensure that we can tell the difference between a returning team with a new name and a new captain and a brand new team to OCUA summer league.

**2005 Preferences** Returning teams have certain privileges when it comes to their historic night of play. These privileges only apply to that night of play and as such if you pick your traditional night, your team will be given priority for spots based on a first received, first placed basis with respect to this document. If you wish to change nights, then fill out the form to keep your returning spot, but under the Preferences section please note your teams desire to change nights, and the night. If another returning team from the night you wish to transfer to wishes to move to your night, then a switch will be arranged, otherwise you will have to join a waiting list. Priority for openings on Monday to Thursday nights will go to the Friday teams, and then on a first in, first served basis.

**Pay before you play!** Please note that OCUA has adopted a pay before you play policy. This means that if your method of payment is not honoured or if a member of your team has outstanding fees due to the Association, you will not be considered as having submitted a valid application and will not be granted a spot. All forms must be in the Association's mail box or postmarked no later than the 20th to be accepted.
