## Before You Register....

Please read the following information before completing the registration form of Page 2.

#### **Team Fees**

Per-team fees for 2008 are \$1150+GST (\$1207.50). A non-refundable deposit of \$200 must accompany the registration form, the balance to be paid at or before the Captains' Meeting. Cheques should be made payable to "OCUA" or "Ottawa-Carleton Ultimate Association".

### Captain's Meeting

Tuesday, April 22nd, 2008 in Salon A at Lansdowne Park. Parking is free at Lansdowne for this event. Attendance by captains or designates is mandatory. More details will be published on the website.

### Captain's and Assistant Captain's Responsibility for safe playing conditions.

Given that OCUA offers the sport of ultimate at varied and dispersed locations, and does not have officials such as referees at the games, it falls to the team captains and assistant captains to be responsible for the safety of the site at which they are playing and for the well-being of their players. Captains are responsible to examine the field of play before their game begins to determine if it is safe. They are ultimately responsible for the actions of their players and must be prepared to take appropriate action if the feel that safety is being compromised. This includes refusing to play on a site they deem to be potentially hazardous, or against an opponent they feel is playing in an unsafe fashion. OCUA never forces its members to play when they are not comfortable doing so; games can easily be rescheduled.

#### **OCUA Member Number**

If your have not already done so, your will need to create an account on Leaguerunner, OCUA's league-management system. Go to http://www.ocua.ca/leaguerunner and follow the instructions. Once your account has been created, you will be given a permanent OCUA member identification number.
