Team Fees

Team fees for 2009 include GST and are provided on Page 2 of this form. A non-refundable deposit of \$200 (\$100 for Sunday Leagues) must accompany this registration form. The balance must be paid at or before the Captains' Meeting. Cheques should be made payable to OCUA or Ottawa-Carleton Ultimate Association. Electronic receipts will be provided on request upon payment of full team fees.

Captains' Meeting

April 21st OR April 22nd (depending on the OHL playoff schedule) in Salon A at Lansdowne Park. Parking is free at Lansdowne for this event. Attendance by captains or designates is mandatory. Final date and more details will be published at www.ocua.ca .

Captain and 2nd Contact Information

OCUA communications with respect to the summer season will be made using this information, primarily through email and Ultimate Happenings. Please ensure this information is accurate and keep OCUA informed of any changes to this information should they occur.

Captain's and Assistant Captain's Responsibility for Safe Playing Conditions

Given that OCUA offers the sport of Ultimate at varied and dispersed locations, and does not have officials such as referees at the games, it falls to the team captains and assistant captains to be responsible for the safety of the site at which they are playing and for the well-being of their players. Captains are responsible to examine the field of play before their game begins to determine if it is safe. They are responsible for the actions of their players and must be prepared to take appropriate action if they feel that the safety of any player on the field is being compromised. This includes refusal to play on a site they deem to be potentially hazardous, or against an opponent they feel is playing in an unsafe fashion. OCUA never forces its members to play in unsafe circumstances; games can be rescheduled.

OCUA Member Number

Every player registered in an OCUA league must have an OCUA member number. If you are new to the Association, you will need to create a Leaguerunner account on OCUA's league-management system. Go to <http://www.ocua.ca/leaguerunner/> and follow the instructions. Once your account has been created, you will be given a permanent OCUA member number. Captains must ensure all team members have an OCUA Member Number.

Leaguerunner

Upon confirmation of acceptance of team registration, captains must create their teams in Leaguerunner. Information regarding this subject can be found on Leaguerunner and within the OCUA FAQ pages on the website.

Night of Play

Priority for openings in Co-ed Monday-Thursday Leagues will go to returning teams followed by 2008 Co-ed Friday teams. OCUA will provide coaching to new Co-ed Friday teams and Co-ed Friday League is highly recommended as an entry point for new teams. Experienced teams may also register for Co-ed Friday League.

PAY Before You Play

OCUA has a pay before you play policy. Fees must be paid in full before play a team can commence play.

Refund Policy

The \$200 deposit (\$100 deposit for Sunday Leagues) to reserve your team's spot is non-refundable after acceptance of registration has been confirmed. Full team fees are non-refundable after the mandatory Captain's Meeting.
